Tutor: Jasper Prachek

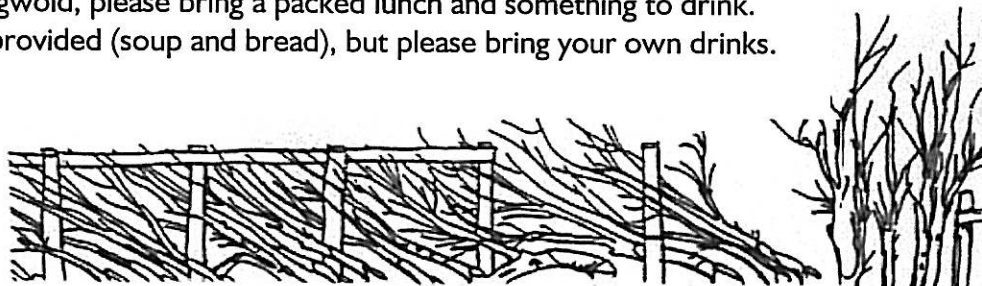
Venue: New Hall Farm, Ardsley, Barnsley (directions will be sent on booking)
